- Butler's Wall – came up in last full Council meeting were removing funding – since then, Heath has managed to successfully amend resolution so council would commit to doing something about wall in next two years. Internal submission for annual plan, forward from infrastructure plan, about some option of what we should or can do to rectify the wall. Unsure what desired plan will be – might need fill, or anchors.
- Tennis Courts – almost done.
- Heath invited to meeting tonight from concerned residents from McDonnell Road – concerned about speed. Couldn't make it due to this meeting but something to listen out for.

Clean Air:

- Susan Rowley – ORC replied: Sarah Harrison says ORC will be doing the usual winter engagement, social media posts etc the same as last year. Also planning a project with community involvement measuring real life emissions from ULEBs. More info to come.
